Porch Concerts Partnership with Brad Bidwell

- 15 porch concert series.
- 1/13 16th porch concert. Sweet 16 drag queen theme!
 - Longer day, 6 houses
 - o Just once a year, attempting for January each year
 - Brad took over porch concert planning as Mike Logan left neighborhood
 - Series of connected private parties
 - o Ran out of personal venmo's, money flow, collection
 - Want more formality to this
 - Partnered with Wheres Safety Team to administer funds
 - Fiscal sponsorships are available when 2 groups' goals match
 - o They are an unaffiliated group, just fun people who plan this
 - Probably a good idea for CNA to have some "arms around" these types of Coronado activities
 - o In need of fiscal sponsor in the CNA
 - Brad fronts money while raising sponsorships, went into non-profit account and piled up there. Submits receipts after events to get reimbursed
 - Not insured
 - Homeowners insurance is what is actually in play they each have liability risk by signing on for each porch concert (the homeowners could get single-day additional coverage)
 - Do we need a strategic stop with both leaded and unleaded beer? This is given TO a homeowner
 - Primarily give away NA beers, mocktails
 - Wheres Safety Team has dropped off. Plugged holes as we could. Now fully accepting responsibility that we have a volunteer coordinator/team specifically for streets/corners to help with safety and navigation
 - Sponsor checks would go to CNA and go into porch concert "bucket"
 - Brad is person guarantor of the event for overages
 - Typically raise \$3-4k. Rough budget is ~\$2,100 obligated for bands and porta-potties. How much can we get the bands to market on our behalf.
 Guarantee them \$100, try to get them to \$300
 - o Robin Banks is the drag queen
